6) <u>Pastor Participation</u> <i>Pastor attending AYS = 500 pts. per week (must give date) Pastor participating in AYS = 1,500 pts. (must give date & activity). Excluding opening and closing prayer. Pastor giving AYS = 3,500 pts. (Max. 2 per year) Describe what Pastor did</i>		
7) <u>Pastor's Appreciation Day-</u> <i>5,000 pts. - 2 per year (hosted specifically by youth dept.-Not the CHURCH).</i>		
8) <u>Recreational Activity/Socials-</u> <i>1,000 pts. each - 2 per month</i>

<p>10) iServe Community Service Project- 5,000 pts. – One per month (5,000 bonus points for projects on Conference Service Weekend. Plus, 5,000 more bonus pts., if you send pictures.</p>		
<p>11) iServe certified uniform worn for service projects- (Black Polo) during the projects along with photos.-10,000 pts.</p>		
<p>12) Youth Day- 2,500 pts. – one per month (Please use your young people on the program & send copy of the bulletin.)</p>		
<p>13) Youth Week of Prayer- 5,000 pts. - 2 per year - Plus 500 pts. For each different young person participating. Please list young person's name and activity.</p>		
<p>14) Education Section- After School Tutorial Program, 1,000 pt. (can only be claimed once per year. - Each church that sends students to Oakwood College's Days - 5,000 pts. (including chaperons / drivers)</p>		
<p>15) Sabbath School Section- 250 pts. per week per member of your staff who visits in either the Earliteen or the Youth Class (if they are not the teacher or the Assistant)</p>		
<p>16) Youth Bringing Youth to Church- 1,000 pts. For each young person under the age 21 who brings another non-Adventist young persons under 21 to a church service. Give the name of both young people and the date. (7000 pts. Max.)</p>
